

VERIFICATION OF QUALIFICATIONS AND CREDENTIALS

North Carolina law requires notice to every applicant for state employment that willfully providing false or misleading information or failing to disclose relevant information shall be grounds for rejection of an application or later disciplinary action or criminal prosecution. Dismissal from employment shall be mandatory in any case in which a false or misleading representation is made in order to meet position qualifications.

The employer is required by law to verify an applicant's representations about credentials and other qualifications relevant to employment.

By executing this employment application, you authorize the release to Appalachian State University, a constituent institution of the University of North Carolina, only of any document or information within the possession of a third party, such as an educational institution or licensure board that may serve to verify any representations made by you in this employment application. Applicable representations are limited to those made in the written Appalachian State University application form, the applicant's submitted resume, and the cover letter submitted at the time of the application.
